The Foundation for Soy Innovation brings together soybean farmers and their partners throughout the soy value chain, working collaboratively toward a stronger future. Launched in 2018, the Foundation is connecting todays leaders with the energy and ideas of the next generation, strengthening partnerships, furthering education and providing support for new technology and the people creating it.

The Foundation for Soy Innovation exists to advance the technology, ingenuity and partnerships integral to the future for soy. Through this scholarship program, the Foundation and its partners support academic and professional development of the next generation of leaders for the soybean value chain.

Scholarships are intended for advanced undergraduate students, graduate students, early-career faculty and young professionals, and may be used for coursework, supplies, specialty training and/or participation in a professional conference.

Applications will be evaluated on their demonstrated educational engagement, professional development and connection to the soy value chain.


- Educational engagement is considered taking relevant coursework and progressing toward degree, certificate or similar completion. It may also include continuing education efforts, as well as teaching academic courses, workshops or similar programs for the education of others connected to the soy value chain.
- Professional development includes efforts to achieve personal and professional goals through networking, personal growth, internships and technical training. Applicants should address not only where they want to be professionally, but also what they are doing to achieve those goals.
- Candidates should demonstrate a strong understanding of the soybean industry and their potential impact on that value chain. The strongest applicants will show impact on the soy value chain through their present situation, as well as through their professional aspirations.

Financial need may also be considered at the discretion of the scholarship committee and Foundation for Soy Innovation leadership.

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age.

Recipients may be asked to participate in a future event or program with the Foundation for Soy Innovation.
